**RULES GOVERNING THE FEIS**

1. In the case of all solo and team competitions in all grades, the age of a competitor on Jan 1<sup>st</sup> of the year in which the competition is held will determine the right of entry. For the purposes of this Rule a competitor whose birthday occurs on Jan 1 shall be deemed to be under the age attained on that date.
2. Competitions are only open to amateurs. Teachers or other professionals cannot compete in the category in which they major. All dancers must be pupils of a person who is currently registered with An Coimisiun as a Dancing Teacher of any category.
3. A competitor may be disqualified for any of the following reasons: A. Conduct unbecoming a lady or gentleman. B. Failure to report on time to compete. (Penalty: Disqualification from said event) C. Falsification of age or other important facts – i.e., teaching, award winning, competing under another competitors name or number, etc. Penalty for A and C: competitor will be disqualified from the Feis at which the occurrence happened and from all NAFC-registered Feisanna for a period of one year beginning at the date of the occurrence.
4. Competitions may be closed if there are no competitors at the assigned stage, ready to compete, when the competition is scheduled or announced. May not pertain to situation where competitors are involved in stage conflicts.
5. Solo competitors in Beginner, Advanced Beginner, Novice, or Prizewinner Competitions: A. Must compete in their own age group. The standard age groups, all levels, are contained in the handbook. B. Must be prepared to perform two steps in each event. C. Cannot change competition on the day of the Feis.
6. Steel taps or "bubble" heels on dancing shoes, display of awards, wearing of shorts or other unconventional dress prohibited. Authentic Gaelic dress is desired. Modest attire is encouraged when competitor is not dancing.
7. Competitors number must be worn and visible to adjudicators when performing in all competitions, EXCEPT IN CHAMPIONSHIPS.
8. Awards will be determined in proportion to the number of competitors entered in each competition and to the degree of proficiency shown.
9. Complaints must be in writing, stating names and other factual information, and signed by the complainant. A \$10 fee must be enclosed and presented to the Feis Chairman within one hour of the occurrence. The fee will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
10. The Feis Committee and any organization affiliated with same will not be held responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage. Destruction of Feis property or rental property will be punishable by law.
11. The Feis reserves the right to reject any entry for cause, or to cancel all or part of the Feis and to limit competitors performing time. The decision of the Feis Committee is final in all matters connected with the Feis.
12. Competitors must answer all questions as required by the Feis Entry Committee, including teacher's name, and enclose the entry fee when mailing or else the entry will be rejected. Entries must be post marked on or before the closing date, or they will be subject to a late fee of \$10.
13. Entrants in any championship event may not enter any other Grade event, but may enter in figure dances. Entrants in championships should indicate choice of set dance. Entrants cannot change competition or category on the day of the competition. A. Standard age groups for Open Championships: See Handbook. \*\* In the case of back-to-back Feisanna, the second Feis shall use the alternate set of age groups. B. Open Championship competitions for boys and girls must be held separately. Boys and girls must be advertised separately, if less than five boys per competition, Feis organizers can combine with the girls' competition in the same age group ON THE DAY OF THE FEIS.
14. Preliminary Championships are open to those who, at any recognized Feis: A. Have placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in each of the Prizewinner solo categories, and B. Have never won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in Open Championships. A dancer who wins two 1<sup>st</sup> place awards in one calendar year will move on to Open Championship the following year, or as soon as the second win is achieved in any age category in the following years. Only in the case of back-to-back Feisanna (successive days), in which case the first win in the first Feis will not change the dancers status for the second Feis. A dancer is required to perform a light shoe dance (Reel or Slip Jig for ladies, and Reel only for Men), and a hard shoe dance. A Feis can opt to offer either (a.) a set dance or (b.) a jig/hornpipe – the dancer's choice.
15. Preliminary Championship competitions may be combined (Boys and Girls). Standard Age Groups for Preliminary Championships – see Handbook.
16. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in the Open Championship category cannot return to a Preliminary or Open (Prizewinner) competition.
17. Placing in a regional or National Oireachtas does not change the status of a competitor.
18. The status of the dancer does not change unless there are five or more dancers in a competition.
19. Grade categories: Competitors have the option to remain in the same category for the remainder of the Feis year.
20. Beginner Grade: A Beginner is a competitor who has not taken a full year of Irish Dance lessons, thereby giving Beginners a full year with such status. A Beginner must move into the Advanced Beginner category the next year. Advanced Beginner Grade: An Advanced Beginner who wins 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place will advance to the Novice category in that particular dance. Competition dances are Reel, Light Jig, Slip Jig, Traditional Treble Jig, and Traditional Open (Prizewinner) Hornpipe, as a minimum requirement. Novice Grade: A Novice who wins a 1<sup>st</sup> place will advance to the category in that particular dance. Open Grade (Prizewinner): A competitor who does not qualify as a Beginner, Advanced Beginner, or as a Novice. Adult Beginner: An adult beginner is a competitor who never took Irish Dancing lessons as a juvenile and is over 18 years of age.
21. Musicians and adjudicators cannot be approached during a competition by anyone except the Feis Committee. No one can approach them while a competitor is performing.
22. Musicians employed by the Feis Committee will be solely under direction and management of the Feis Committee on Feis Day.
23. Figure Dancing: Teachers or team captains are responsible that their teams are complete and in position when the competition is announced. Competitors may compete in the next higher age group, however a competitor may compete in only one age group.
24. In matters pertaining to the adjudication the decision of the adjudicators is final.
25. Adjudicators are to monitor the quality of music at the stage(s) to which they are assigned.
26. The use of flash, video, digital, or motion picture cameras is prohibited during a dance competition except for press use or Feis Committee documentation.
27. Figure dancing competitions are optional. Should a Feis offer Figure Dancing competitions, the standard age groups and categories contained in the Handbook are required.
28. The Feis Committee reserves the right to combine competitions.
29. There will be no coolers allowed on the premises. Refreshments will be available at the Feis.
30. Entry fee for championship dances includes marks, which will be given out following the announcements of awards, if time permits.
31. Other competition scores will be made available by mail for a \$2 fee, to be paid at the Feis. Please fill out an envelope, found at the awards table.
32. As of September 1, 2005 no block en point stationary or moving may be performed by any ages up to and including Under 12 age groups.

**DIRECTIONS:**

**From I-95 Northbound** Follow I-95 North to Route 25/8 North (Exit 27A) - Bear right 4 miles on Route 8 North - Get off Route 108 Stratford Exit - Turn left at end of ramp - Take a right a light onto Route 108 - Take a left at 2nd light onto Connors Lane - Take a left 6/10 mile onto Weaver Drive. Gym entrance is in front of the school.

**From I-95 Southbound** Follow I-95 South to Exit 32 - Left off ramp - Take a left at light onto West Broad - Left at light onto Main Street - Go over Post Road (US 1) - Bear left at fork just past People's Bank onto Huntington Road - Take left at light onto Connors Lane - Take second right onto Weaver Drive. Entrance is in front of school.

**From the Merritt Parkway Northbound** Follow the Merritt Parkway (Route 15 North) - Get off (Exit 51) Rt. 108 Stratford - Take a right off the ramp - At 5th light take a left onto Connors Lane - Take a left six-tenths of a mile onto Weaver Drive. Entrance is in front of School.

**From the Merritt Parkway Southbound** Follow the Merritt Parkway (Route 15 South) - Get off (Exit 52) - Bear left onto Rt. 8 South - Bear right on Rt. 108 - At the end of the ramp take a left - Take left at the 3rd light onto Connors Lane - Follow Connors Lane for about six-tenths of a mile - Take a left onto Weaver Drive. Entrance is in front of school.
